- \$20,000 supports travel, accommodation and food, a medical kit, and a solar LED lighting system for 25 women
- \$200,000 supports a full year of training courses

Maternal health is a major issue in Africa: 50 percent of the world's maternal deaths happen in Africa. About 1,500 maternal deaths happen in Africa every day.

The Morogoro Women's Training Centre is training 250 maternal health care workers each year. They plan to offer ten 11-day courses each year for the next three years. The goal is to train 750 maternal health care workers over the three years.

Working with the Tanzanian Ministry of Health, the centre trains women on birthing techniques, as well as proper nutrition, emergency first aid, and CPR. Women from remote communities are able to expand their role beyond basic maternal care and act as community health care workers. Education and awareness about the negative effects of female genital mutilation are also taught.
