

Anti-Racism Action Ideas from Global Partners

- Affirm God's image in every human being, irrespective of racial background.
- Enhance your own awareness and understanding of racism and xenophobia by talking to others, reading, and listening.
- Examine your own attitudes and stereotypes and your behaviour to see whether they contribute to or combat racism and xenophobia around you.
- Re-evaluate your own use of terms or phrases that may be experienced by others as degrading and hurtful.
- Openly disagree with racist comments, jokes, or actions by those around you.
- Reach out to others and journey together across racial lines, taking one step at a time to overcome subtle and deep-seated prejudices, because these will not be eradicated overnight.
- Teach your children from an early age to respect people, whatever their race, and give them opportunities to mix freely across race groups; also in your own home.
- Help your church to become a place where people of all races are actively welcomed and included in all activities.
- Encourage your church to set up encounter groups where people of different races can learn to understand each other.
