Side by Side – Soriak Development Challenge

The Soriak Development Challenge is a simulation game designed to deepen our understanding of the complexity of development. Groups of four to six participants will act as the governments of developing countries, setting government priorities and allocating resources. Each government will have a set number of points corresponding to the priority level they assign to sectors of their society. The governments will then be faced with a series of development challenges. The decisions that each government takes will impact the point level and budgets!

Time Frame

The game has four rounds, takes about 2 to 2.5 hours to play, and includes a set of questions for debriefing.
