

United Church Statistics

The United Church is Canada's largest Protestant denomination, with over 2 million Canadians who, when asked by Statistics Canada in 2011, identified their religion as United Church.

The United Church was formed in 1925 through the union of Canadian Methodists, Congregationalists, Local Union Churches, and 70% of Canadian Presbyterians.

As of December 31, 2017, the United Church is organized into

- 13 regional Conferences
- 85 district presbyteries
- 2,119 local pastoral charges
- 2,774 individual congregations

The United Church has

- 3,428 ordained ministers: 2,070 men/1,358 women
- 289 diaconal ministers: 27 men/262 women
- 151 designated lay ministers (under appointment)
